QUILT FEST 2008 – QUILT CATEGORIES

Definition of a quilt: 1. A quilt consists of 3 layers: two layers of cloth filled with “batting” material held together by stitched design. Quilt may be embellished with material other than cloth. 2. Something that is quilted or resembles a quilt.

- Any quilt previously shown at a Decatur Quilt Guild Show will be accepted for exhibition ONLY.
- A quilt that needs special handling or has a wooden frame will NOT be accepted for hanging.
- Quilts must be hand or machine quilted – NOT TIED.
- The committee reserves the right to refuse to hang any item entered.
- Crazy quilts can be shown but will not be eligible for voting unless they are antique or quilted.

In order to organize our quilt show we have assigned categories to quilts depending on their **age, size, type, and methods used.**

Please Read The Following Descriptions Carefully. Then Select the Category That Best Fits Your Quilt. Put That Number On The Pre-Registration Form. We reserve the right to change the category of any item(s) based on description given, or when delivered on THURSDAY, MARCH 29.

LARGE SIZE QUILTS - Over 60” on any side.

| 100 | Appliqué’ | A design made by cutting shapes of one or more fabrics and applying them to the surface of another fabric by hand or machine. |
| 200 | Pieced Hand Quilted | Pieced by hand and quilted by hand. |
| 300 | Pieced Machine Quilted | Pieced by machine and machine quilted. |
| 400 | Pieced Combination | Pieced by hand or machine. Quilted by hand or machine. |
| 500 | Embroidery | Uses a stitching technique by hand or machine on cloth that is then put into the quilt. Includes all embroidered top or blocks set together. |
| 600 | Antique | A quilt that had been finished <u>over 50 years ago.</u> This includes the top, quilting and binding. |
| 700 | Combination | Construction using more than one technique, which could include piecing, appliqué, embroidery, or surface design like stenciling, painting or computer graphics. By hand or machine. |
| 800 | Whole Cloth | Technique where the entire expression of design results from the quilting motif by hand or machine. |

SMALL SIZE QUILTS / WALL HANGINGS 60 inches and under

| 900 | Small Wall hanging | <u>Small – 36” or less on all sides.</u> Wall hangings are quilted pieces that may or may not be made for the purpose of hanging on a wall. |
| 1000 | Large Wall hanging | <u>Large – Over 36” and less than 60”.</u> Wall hangings are quilted pieces that may or may not be made for the purpose of hanging on a wall. |
| 1100 | Crib | Any designed quilt made by hand or machine to be used on a child’s bed and smaller than twin size. |
| 1200 | Miniature | Quilts that are scaled to miniature – <u>not more than 24” x 24.</u> |

SPECIAL CATAGORIES

| 1300 | Clothing | <u>More than half</u> of each garment must contain patchwork piecing and/or appliqué and/or quilting, machine or hand technique. |
| 1400 | Holiday | All Holiday items. We do not show dolls or stuffed items. |
| 1500 | Home Décor | Quilted items that are used to decorate a home such as pillows, table runners, place mats, etc. More than half of each item must contain patchwork, piecing and/or appliqué and/or quilting, Machine or hand technique. |
| 1600 | Children/Youth | Made by a person 16 years of age or younger. Not eligible for “Viewer’s Choice Vote.” All entries will receive a “Participant” ribbon. <u>Please give age of maker after their “Name” on the Pre-registration Form.</u> |
| 1700 | Quilt Fest Theme | Quilts that have been designed especially for the theme of the show, Rainbow quilts. May be any combination of techniques. |
| 1800 | Challenge Quilts | Designs by Guild members to showcase the challenge fabric distributed by the Guild. |
| 2000 | Bed Turning | Quilts to be used specifically for the bed turning (Guild Member Only) |
| 2100 | Rail Quilts | Those quilts to be hung on the railing. (Guild Member Only) |
| 3000 | UFO/Rail Quilts | Items to be used specifically for the UFO wall display (Guild Member Only) |
