UFO Challenge 2010

Let's make this year the year that we finish our UFO's. Here is how we are going to do this as a guild so both night and day members will be doing the challenge together. There will be prizes at the end of the challenge period. So go thru your sewing room, totes, etc and find those projects that you forgot about and get them finished. The projects can be just started, almost finished, or all bundled ready to start (pattern and fabric altogether waiting to be made).

If you find projects you don't want to finish bring them to me all bagged up we will have some fun with these (will need to have supplies to complete the project or at least the top if a quilt)

- You will need to register to participate.
- Participation fee is 1 fat quarter (quilt shop quality).
- Submit 10 or more UFO projects with a description of what needs to be done to finish the project(a set of placemats, napkins, etc is considered one project)
- The deadline for completion of projects is Dec 7-8, 2010.
- Once you have completed a project, you must show it at a guild meeting to verify that it's a completed project and indicate it was on your UFO list, and then a completion date will be posted for this project on your list and 1 point added.
- Most points wins. Plus other prizes.

We suggest that you make a list of all of the projects and submit 10 at a time and when some of the projects are completed you add more to the challenge list, but you can add them all if you wish at one time (more incentive to finish if on the list)

Erika Phillips has volunteered to create the Excel spread sheet to maintain your list and points. Erika will send you a list of your projects after she has entered them in Excel (for those without email she will print out a copy for you)

Give Erika a list of your projects and descriptions with name and email address (if don't have one that is ok too) on it.
